- Learn about the safety implications of various packaging types and understand how net quantity limitations impact the secure transport of dangerous goods by air. Learn to apply these principles in compliance with regulatory standards to minimize risk and ensure shipment integrity
- End-to-end communication of hazards and handling requirements using correct marks and labels
- Understand the regulatory requirements for packing, marking, and labelling dangerous goods, including UN specification packaging, limited quantity provisions, and other approved packaging types. Learn to apply correct procedures to ensure compliance and safe transport
- Reporting to appropriate authorities as required
